

Care symbols and what they mean

Look for them sewn inside your garments.



Suitable for a normal machine cycle. The numbers in the box indicate the temperature.



Machine wash on a delicate/low spin speed cycle.



Machine wash on a wool cycle.



The triangle symbol indicates that non-chlorine bleach can be used. The cross through the triangle indicates DO NOT BLEACH.



The dots in the iron symbol indicated the temperature that should be used. Three dots means a high setting (usually cotton and linen).

Two dots mean a warm setting (usually synthetics)

One dot means a cool setting (usually silk)

The cross through the symbol indicates DO NOT IRON



The symbol containing a letter indicates the garment is suitable for dry cleaning. The letter indicates to the dry cleaner which solvents should be used. The cross through the symbol indicates DO NOT DRY CLEAN.



This symbol refers to tumble-drying.

Two dots indicate a warmer setting (usually for cottons)

One dot indicates a cooler setting (usually synthetics)

The cross through the symbol indicates DO NOT TUMBLE DRY.
